

WINE

France, Beaujolais | *Chardonnay*
A beautiful accident. Intended to be a still wine, it went through a 2nd fermentation & became a delicious & refreshing pet-nat.
- 2014 **Quarticello, Ferrando** £40
Italy, Emilia Romagna | *Lambrusco Salamino*
A little bitter and tart, it's the perfect tonic to wake up the palate.
- 2015 **Franck Peillot, Montagnieu Methode Traditionelle, Brut Bugey** £48
France, Savoie | *Altesse, Chardonnay, Mondeuse Noire*
Ripe red fruits from the mondeuse give the wine a delicious lift.

Germany, Saar Valley | *Riesling*
Beautifully textured, cremant style fizz from this progressive German winemaker. Refreshing & food friendly.
- NV **Lamiable, Brut Grand Cru** £75
France, Champagne | *Pinot Noir, Chardonnay*
Grower Champagne. Grand Cru vineyards. Worth every penny
- 1992 **Peter Lauer, Zero Dosage, Réserve 92** £125
Germany, Saar Valley | *Riesling*
Disgorged to order with at least 24 years on the lees. Stunning character & delicacy. This is frankly just something special.

- 2015 **Réserve de Gassac, Rosé Pays d'Hérault** £25
France, Languedoc | *Grenache blend*
Light & summery, you can drink this with anything.
- 2015 **L'Acino, Asor** £43
Italy, Calabria | *Magliocco*
Rich & generous but with a clean mineral kick. Our kind of rosé.
- 2015 **Nino Barraco** £56
Italy, Sicily | *Catarratto*
We find this style of wine can be divisive, but Nino's is a real crowd pleaser.
- 2009-14 **La Macération du Soula, n°14 Vin de France** £66
France, Roussillon | *Vermentino, Macabeu, Sauvignon*
Serious winemaking here with an unmistakable Roussillon style.
- 2015 **Pierre Frick, Macération Vorbourg Grand Cru** £70
France, Languedoc | *Pinot Gris*
intended as a Crémant but JP felt the wine was too 'horizontal', so he macerated to give it verticality. Or as he said, more 'PFFT!'
- 2013 **Leon Barral Vin de France** £75
France, Languedoc | *Terret Gris & Blanc, Viognier, Roussanne*
Intense mix of sherry and honey aroma's with pure citrus fruit.

- 2015 **Les Petits Clément Côtes du Tarn** £25
France, Gaillac | *Sauvignon, Mauzac*
Understated and yet happily satisfying.
- 2014 **Clos Armand Muscadet (Sèvre et Maine) Sur Lie** £33
France, Loire | *Melon de Bourgogne*
A rich texture whilst its delicacy and freshness is retained.
- 2015 **Angiolino Maule, Masieri** £35
Italy, Veneto | *Garganega & other variety*
Spontaneously fermented grapes grown in volcanic soils using natural methods. Unfiltered juice, without added sulfites.
- 2015 **Meinklang, Sziklafehér** £36
Hungary, Somló | *Juhfark, Harslevelú, Olaszriesling*
Fresh & aromatic but balanced by the tough volcanic soils where these grapes grow. Crunchy fruit and very quaffable.
- 2015 **Domaine de Majas Côtes Catalanes** £36
France, Roussillon | *Macabeu, Vermentino, Carignan Blanc*
Hints of fresh lime peel & dried fruits with a lively minerality.
- 2015 **Yves Duport, Les Cotes Bugey** £38
France, Savoie | *Chardonnay*
Drinking well, excellent value with plenty of character & a real sense of place. Clean & fresh.
- 2011 **Philipp Vesper, Mülheimer Sonnenlay Kabinett** £39
Germany, Mosel | *Riesling*
Plenty of ripe fruit here but the acidity is so invigorating you can't put it down. Amazingly fresh considering it's age & food friendly.
- 2015 **Domaine Léon Boesch, La Cabane** £39
France, Alsace | *Pinot Auxerrois, Pinot Blanc*
The ultimate 'bistro' wine. Lots of character & super versatile.
- 2015 **Pierre Frick** £41
France, Alsace | *Chasselas*
No added sulphur & time on the lees. This has a smoky, rich nose with a keen acidity. Think dried bananas & sour greengage.
- 2015 **La Distesa, Terre Silvate** £42
Italy, Marche | *Verdicchio, Trebbiano*
A small percentage sits on skins for a few days adding grip, while six months on lees lends flesh. Dry, nutty and savoury.
- 2015 **Monteforche, Cassiara** £42
Italy, Veneto | *Moscato, Garganega*
It is a humble & honest wine which is nourishing and delicious.
- 2015 **Alberto Nanclares Rias Baixas** £43
Spain, Galicia | *Albariño*
A great expression of this quintessential Spanish grape.

Italy, Trentino <i>Nosiola</i> <i>Italy's answer to the Loire; a perfect combination of total ripeness, total dryness and low alcohol. Expect robust minerality</i>	
NV Orsi San Vito, Posca Bianca	£45
Italy, Emilia-Romagna <i>Pignoletto</i> <i>A perpetual blend of mostly Pignoletto. Bottled to order, this is an everyday wine for the table, with a lemony, salty twang.</i>

France, Loire <i>Chenin Blanc</i> <i>Intense minerality in harmony with that classic richness of Loire Chenin. A low-intervention approach gives it a nice fresh kick.</i>

France, Loire <i>Chenin Blanc</i> <i>So close to Chablis it shares terroir but just far enough south that it loses the price tag. Round & racy, this is drinking beautifully.</i>

France, Savoie <i>Altesse</i> <i>Recommended to us by Jill next door in Noble Fine Liquor. This is an exceptional wine which really compliments the weather.</i>

France, Loire <i>Sauvignon Blanc</i> <i>Beautifully aromatic, complex and unique Sauvignon from one of the remotest parts of the Loire. This won't last long in your glass</i>

France, Southern Rhône | Syrah, Grenache, Carignan
Biodynamic, fun & fresh. A perfect spring red; there's fruit & structure here but overall it's thirst quenching juice.

France, Bergerac | Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec
Rich, natural, unfiltered and unfiltered with a long finish and an overall impression of freshness.

Southern Italian table wine with fruit, structure & spice.

Floral & fruity, this packs a good punch and is super refreshing.

This wine is given just the same care as Charvin's Châteauneuf. Rich, complex fruit and a spicy, natural, unforced quality.

Italy, Piedmont | Nebbiolo
'Piemonte Nuovo'. Juicy, fun & pure - you can sip on this all night; its got structure & acidity but its all about fresh, crunchy berries.

France, Provence | Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault
Rich, heady & powerful, yet open, balanced & well integrated. We hunted down this producer after drinking their wines in Lyon.

Verticle, precise Pinot. A proper Germanic expression of the heartbreak grape. Fresh acidity that'll cut through our food well.

France, Roussillon | Syrah, Carignan, Grenache
A blend of 5 vintages with aromas of red fruits & spices combined with more floral notes. The palate, fine & focused, is very fresh.

France, Southern Rhône | Grenache
Experimental, energetic producer. It's a 'living' wine that will keep you well nourished. A real underdog on this list.

Bojo that's best served chilled. Delicious juice.

France, Bugey | Pinot Noir
Beautiful & lively cool climate Pinot. It's delicacy and depth gives Burgundians a run for their money.

France, Roussillon | Grenache Noir, Grenache Gris, Macabeu
A groovy co-ferment of white & red grapes for a playful Roussillon "nouveau"

France, Beaujolais | Gamay
Pure and quaffable, you won't find much better quality than this. Focused & clean from an up & coming producer.

This wine is all about terroir, a tense yet harmonious balance of acidity and minerality makes this a great introduction to Sicily.

France, Roussillon | Syrah, Mourvèdre, Grenache, Carignan
Serious but juicy from the legend of Roussillon. Aromatic blackcurrant & licorice on the nose with a fresh & mineral palate.

France, Loire | Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir, Côt, Gamay
Perfect spring cuvée from a disciple of Claude Courtois. Low alcohol & super digestible but there's a lot of depth here too.
- 2009 **Sébastien Bobinet, Amatéüs bobî Saumur Champigny** £51
France, Loire | Cabernet Franc
A fantastic find. Our supplier has been sitting on this & finally it's drinking beautifully. Bobinet's last traditional method cuvée.

- 2014 **La Distesa, Nocenzio** £52
Italy, Marche | Sangiovese, Montepulciano
Each grape is harvested at different times in the year to ensure they are properly ripe. Full of good structure & powerful tannins.
- 2009 **Cellar Escoda-Sanahuja, Coll del Sabater Conca de Barbera** £53
Spain, Catalunya | Cabernet Franc, Merlot
Deep and Mediterranean, rich of tertiary perfumes, fresh and long. Bordeaux-esque but, this is definitely Spanish.
- 2013 **G rard Boulay Sancerre** £56
France, Loire | Pinot Noir
Pinot from the Loire rather than its more famous neighbour to the east might raise an eyebrow but it shouldn't. This is great.
- 2015 **Olek Bondonio, Giulietta Langhe** £58
Italy, Piedmont | Pelaverga
A peculiar heirloom variety native to Piedmont. It produces a pale, brisk wine perfumed with strawberries and black pepper.
- 2012 **HP Ziereisen, Gestad** £61
Germany, Baden | Syrah
If you thought Pinot Noir was hard to cultivate. Try growing Syrah on the border of France, Germany and Switzerland.
- 2013 ** tienne Courtois, L'caunais Vin de France** £63
France, Loire | Gascon
Earthy, fresh and with a real delicate structure. Deep red fruit and uplifting acidity from one of our favourite Loire producers.
- 2013 **J.Christopher, Willamette Valley** £63
USA, Oregon | Pinot Noir
Interesting collab. between Oregon & Mosel winemakers. New world vibes but plenty of Germanic character too. A great find.
- 2011 **Le Soula, Terroir d'altitude - Vin du Fenouill des C tes Catalanes** £63
France, Roussillon | Carignan, Syrah, Grenache
A passion project of G rard Gauby who saw the potential of these high altitude, extremely old vine vineyards. Earthy but, refined.
- 2015 **Matthieu Barret, Et la banni re... Crozes Hermitage** £65
France, Rh ne | Syrah
This is banging. There's power here, but with so much fresh black fruit and balanced acidity it's already drinking incredibly well.
- 2011 **ArPePe, Sassella Stella Retica Valtellina Superiore** £71
Italy, Lombardy | Nebbiolo
Delicate Alpine Nebbiolo from the rocky upper reaches of the Sassella cru. A profoundly mineral wine with juicy red berries.
- 2013 **Gilles Berlioz, La Deuse Chignin** £72
France, Savoie | Mondeuse, Persan
A memory of times past when wines alcohol levels were lower. Sappy, racy fruit, with a wonderful texture and real digestibility.
